



Our one of a kind gel coated fiberglass collectors set us apart from our competitors. The collector boxes are weather resistant due to the unique fiberglass design and will never rust or crack due to ice or snow.

We also offer our bronze and white split collector boxes for retro-fits and repair for 16" round columns, 8", 10", and 12" square columns. The convex design does not allow frozen water to destroy the collector.

Our perimeter gutters are 8 inches wide by 6 inches deep, which allows maximum flow capability, as well as ease of cleaning. No center gutters are required on canopies less than 44 feet wide. Superior Canopy also uses tapered leads, which drain the water from the perimeter gutter to the circular collectors. The leads are offset one inch from the bottom of the gutters and this ensures that there is never any standing water left in the perimeter gutter. We also offer a 15' downspout in order to create a seamless finish.

Why Choose Superior Canopy?

Our engineering standards for our canopies are much more conservative than our competitors, ensuring that our canopies will be structurally sound for many years to come. Our canopies can be designed and engineered with possible future expansion in mind, and to minimize cost if it ever does arise.

We use heavier 20 gage sheet metal to construct our decking and gutters, giving our customer maximum durability with either smooth or embossed finish available. The stronger gauge material reduces the "dimpling" or "oil canning" effect often seen on lesser quality decking. This thicker gauged steel also allows for the canopy to be serviced from the top without damaging the decking.

The decking is also painted with a high gloss paint that reflects 80% of light, which often allows for less lighting fixtures to be used. Since there are no penetrations in the decking when attached, there is no potential for rust or corrosion.
